About SkyScout Browser

SkyScout Browser is a light-weight web browser based on Chromium Engine Framework that connects and opens SkyScout interface directly in full screen mode and improves performance if several browser windows are opened.

It is strongly recommended for home cockpit makers willing to have more than one EFIS screen.

This browser is free and provided to be used with SkyScout for Windows only, without any commercial responsibility, liability or support.

We provide this free tool as an optional resource for SkyScout "As Is" and "As Available" without warranty of any kind. Use it at your sole risk only.

SkyScout Browser installation and usage

Download SkyScoutBrowser.zip from downloads and extract the files in your desired folder, there are not mandatory folder location for this software, but it has to be in the same computer where SkyScout and X-Plane are installed in.

Create a shortcut, desktop icon, to the SkyScoutBrowser.exe included in the installed folder.

When SkyScoutBrowser.exe is executed, it opens a full screen maximized browser and it connects automatically with SkyScout landing page.

Using F10 and F11 function keys or - and + keys in numeric keyboard, SkyScout Browser is moved to previous or next monitor, if multiple monitors are installed in the system.

Multiple instances of SkyScoutBrowser.exe can be opened and used with different SkyScout EFIS screens.

Press ESC key to close and exit SkyScoutBrowser.exe.

Multiple predefined desktop icons can be created pointing to the same SkyScoutBrowser.exe and adding the monitor number as a parameter, I.E. SkyScoutBrowser.exe 3 to place SkyScout browser in monitor #3
